The Court made the following: ORDER

THE HON'BLE THE CHIEF JUSTICE ALOK ARADHE

AND

THE HON'BLE SRI JUSTICE J.SREENIVAS RAO

WRIT PETITION No.28444 of 2024

ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Alok Aradhe).*

Mr. Abdul Kabeer, learned counsel for the petitioners.

Mr. T.Ramesh, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Health, Medical & Family Welfare Department for respondent No.1.

Mr. G.Ravi, learned counsel representing Mr. A.Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences (hereinafter referred to as, 'the University') for respondent No.2.

2. With the consent of the parties, the matter is heard finally.

3. In this writ petition, the petitioners *inter alia* have prayed for the following relief:

“For the reasons stated above, it is prayed that this Hon’ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents particularly the 2nd respondent in not considering the petitioners request for online registration for admission into MBBS/BDS course under Management Quota “C” (NRI) Category in next phase of counseling for the academic year 2024-25 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to consider and permit the petitioners to upload online application for admission into MBBS/BDS course under Management Quota “C” (NRI) category for the academic year 2024-25 in next phase of counseling and pass such other order or orders as this Hon’ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case.”

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that inadvertently the petitioners could not register for admission under management quota “C” category i.e., NRI category. Therefore, the University is not permitting the petitioners to seek admission under Management Quota for “C” (NRI) category. He further submitted that the petitioners be granted liberty to submit a representation to

the University and the University be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.

5. Learned Standing Counsel for the University submitted that the last date of registration was 23.08.2024 and thereafter, merit list has been prepared, which shall be published at the time of indicating the web options. However, it is fairly submitted by him that in case the petitioners submit a representation, the same shall be dealt with by the University in accordance with law.

6. In view of the aforesaid submission and in the peculiar facts of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to submit a representation before the University with regard to their grievance. Needless to state that in case such a representation is made, the University shall decide the same within a period of three (03) days thereafter. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.
