Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue any appropriate writ, order or direction, one more particularly in the nature of writ of Mandamus, declaring the action of the Respondents, more particularly Respondent No.2, in not considering the petitioner representation dated 06-10-2024 for counseling and admission into MBBS/BDS Course under NRI(C) Category for the academic year 2024-25 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the Respondents to consider the petitioner's representation to include the petitioner name for or next round of counseling/stay vacancies for admission into the MBBS/BDS Course 'NRI (C) Category for the academic year 2024-25 in next round of counseling.

**WRIT PETITION No.28384 of 2024**

**ORDER:** *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Alok Aradhe)*

Mr. Narsing Rao Moraparaju, learned counsel for the petitioner.

Mr. A. Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences (hereinafter referred to as 'the University') representing respondent No.2.

2. With the consent of the parties, the writ petition is heard finally.
3. In this writ petition, the petitioner *inter alia* has prayed for the following relief:

"For the reasons stated in the accompanying affidavit, it is prayed that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of writ of mandamus declaring the action of the respondents more particularly the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent in not considering the petitioner representation dated 06.10.2024 for counselling and admission into MBBS/BDS course under NRI (C) category for the academic year 2024-25 as illegal, arbitrary, unconstitutional and consequently direct the

respondents to consider the petitioner's representation to include the petitioner name for or next round of counselling/stay vacancies for admission into MBBS/BDS course NRI (C) category for the academic year 2024-25 in next round of counselling and pass such other order or orders as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the circumstances of the case."

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that inadvertently the petitioner could not register for admission into MBBS/BDS course under management quota "C" Category i.e., NRI category. Therefore, the University is not permitting the petitioner to seek admission under management quota "C" (NRI) category. He further submitted that the petitioner be granted liberty to submit a representation to the University, and the University be directed to decide the said representation in a time bound manner.
5. Learned Standing Counsel for the University submitted that the last date of registration was 23.08.2024 and thereafter, merit list has been prepared, which shall be published at the time of indicating the web option. However, it is fairly submitted by him that, in case the petitioner

submits a representation, the same shall be dealt with by the University in accordance with law.

6. In view of the aforesaid submission and in the peculiar facts of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation before the University with regard to his grievance. Needless to state that in case such a representation is made, the University shall decide the same within a period of three (03) days thereafter. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
