Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction, more particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the Respondent No.2 in not considering the representations dated 16/10/2024 sent through e-mail to permit the petitioners for 2nd phase of counseling under MBBS/BDS Courses under Management Quota ('B'-Category, 'C'-Category/NRI) for the Academic Year 2024 - 25, as arbitrary, illegal, unconstitutional and violative of Article 14, 21A of the Constitution of India and consequently direct the respondents No. 2 to accept the representations dated 16/10/2024 sent through e-mail and permit the petitioners to opt for 2nd phase of WEB options for B & C category for the academic year 2024-25.

WRIT PETITION No.28875 of 2024

ORDER: *(Per the Hon'ble the Chief Justice Alok Aradhe)*

Mr. Abdul Kabeer, learned counsel for the petitioners.

Mr. G. Ravi, learned counsel represents Mr. A. Prabhakar Rao, learned Standing Counsel for Kaloji Narayana Rao University of Health Sciences (hereinafter referred to as 'the University') representing respondent No.2.

2. With the consent of the parties, the writ petition is heard finally.

3. In this writ petition, the petitioners *inter alia* seek a direction to respondent No.2 to accept the representation dated 16.10.2024 submitted by the petitioners through e-mail and permit the petitioners to opt for second phase of web options for B and C category for admission into MBBS/BDS course for the academic year 2024-25.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that on account of ill-health, the petitioners could not apply for counselling in respect of B and C category seats. It is further submitted that with regard to the grievance of the petitioners, the petitioners have submitted representation dated

16.10.2024. It is also submitted that the aforesaid representation failed to evoke any response and the writ petition be disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation by a speaking order.

5. On the other hand, learned Standing Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that suitable action on the aforesaid representation shall be taken by respondent No.2.

6. In view of the aforesaid submission and in the peculiar facts of the case, the Writ Petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 University to decide the representation submitted by the petitioners by a speaking order within one week from today. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merits of the matter.

Miscellaneous applications, if any pending, shall stand closed. There shall be no order as to costs.
